

BYLAW NO. 108

A BYLAW TO RESTRICT THE WEIGHT OF VEHICLES USING ROADS and BRIDGES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Bone Creek No. 108 of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:-

1. It shall be unlawful to drive any vehicle on or over any road or bridge within the municipality when the weight of such vehicle, with or without its load, exceeds the maximum weight herein specified:-
  - (a) For a two-axle truck . . . . . 24,000 pounds
  - (b) For a three-axle truck . . . . . 32,000 pounds
  - (c) For a semi-trailer unit . . . . . 40,000 pounds
  - (d) For a trailer . . . . . 20,000 pounds
  - (e) For any combination of the above . . . . . 40,000 pounds
  - (f) For a passenger carrying motor vehicle . . . . . 32,000 pounds
  - (g) For any other vehicle, building, object . . . . . 20,000 pounds  
or contrivance
2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1 above, the maximum weight on any axle of any vehicle shall not exceed 18,000 pounds; the maximum weight on any wheel of any vehicle shall not exceed 500 pounds per inch width of tire, and the maximum weight of any passenger carrying vehicle shall not exceed 450 pounds per inch width of tire.
3. The provisions of this bylaw shall not apply to any provincial highway or bridges thereon.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
5. Bylaw No. 83 approved on April 30, 1945 is hereby repealed. READ THREE TIMES by unanimous vote, and passed by the council of The Rural Municipality of Bone Creek No. 108 at Instow in the Province of Saskatchewan this 11th day of April A.D. 19 55.
