

BYLAW NO. 110

*Approved by law*

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE APPOINTMENT  
OF A COMMITTEE RE: MUNICIPAL ROADS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Bone Creek No. 108 of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:-

1. No person shall operate a tractor at any time and for any period ordered by a committee appointed by resolution of the council on any of the roads specified in such order.
2. No person shall operate any other vehicle, the weight of which with its load exceeds Six Thousand Pounds at any time and for any period ordered by a committee appointed by resolution of the Council as mentioned in Section 1 hereof on any of the roads specified in such Order.
3. The said committee shall have authority to impose or to remove the prohibition or restriction mentioned in Section 1 and 2 hereof on any road or roads specified herein at any time.
4. The provisions of Section 1 and 2 hereof shall not apply to any provincial highway.
5. No person shall deface, injure, knock down, or remove any notice posted by authority of a committee appointed under this bylaw.
6. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
