## BYLAW TO DESIGNATE MUNICIPAL HERITAGE PROPERTY BYLAW NO. 1-2000

A bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Bone Creek No. 108, to designate a site as Municipal Heritage Property.

WHEREAS Sections 11 and 12 of The Heritage Property Act authorize the Council of a Municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings, features and structures thereon, to be of heritage value; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality has determined that the lands and premises known as: ILLERBRUN CHURCH

located at: NW corner of the NW 9-11-18-3 is a site of architectural, historical, cultural, environmental, archaeological, palaeontological, aesthetic and/or scientific value; and,

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality has caused, not less than thirty (30) days prior to consideration of this bylaw, a Notice of Intention to Designate to be:

- a. served on the owners of said property
- b. served on the Registrar of Heritage Property
- registered on the Certificate of Title for said property in the appropriate
  Land Titles Office; and
- d. published in at least one issue of a newspaper with general circulation the Municipality; and

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Council of the Municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as Municipal Heritage Property the real property legally described as: all that portion of the North West Quarter of Section 9 Township 11 Range 18 West of the Third Meridian, Saskatchewan 4.0 acres described as follows:Commencing at the North West corner of the Quarter Section; thence Easterly along the Northern boundary 5 chains; thence Southerly and parallel with the Western boundary 8 chains; thence Westerly and parallel with the Northern boundary to the Western Boundary; thence Northerly along the Western boundary to the point of commencement EXCEPT: 0.13 acre as Parcel A for Roadway on Plan 64SC08312 MINERALS IN THE CROWN

The reasons for the designation as follows:

Built in 1915 - is one of few remaining prominent old buildings in the area. A large, well constructed building, visible for several miles and a treasured landmark for many people

In need of exterior repair and maintenance in order to maintain the structure

- 2. The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to cause a Notice of Designation to be:
  - a. registered on the Certificate of Tittle for said property at the appropriate Land Titles Office; and,
  - b. served on the owners of said property.
- 3. The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be served on the Registrar of Heritage Property
