Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


1. That the municipal agreement between the following municipalities:

Town of Shaunavon
 Town of Eastend
 Village of Colford
 Rural Municipality of White Valley No. 49
 Rural Municipality of Crows Creek No. 78
 Rural Municipality of Arlington No. 79, and
 Rural Municipality of Bone Creek No. 108,


to establish and operate a regional park to be known as the URBAN CREL REGIONAL PARK, consisting of "Shaunavon Division", "Eastend Division" and "Pine Creeks Division", be sealed and signed by the signing officers of the respective municipalities.

2. That a copy of the said agreement shall be identified as Schedule "A" and attached to forming a part of this bylaw.
3. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.



MUNICIPAL AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made the

THE TOWN OF SHAUNAVON, a corporate body under the authority of The Town Act of the Province of Saskatchewan, hereinafter referred to as "Shaunavon"

the party of the first part

- and -

THE TOWN OF EASTEND, a corporate body under the authority of THE TOWN Act of the Province of Saskatchewan, hereinafter referred to as "Eastend"

the party of the second part

- and -

THE VILLAGE OF DOLLARD, a corporate body under the authority of The Village Act of the Province of Saskatchewan, hereinafter referred to as "Dollard"

the party of the third part

- and -

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF WHITE VALLEY NO. 49, a municipal corporation of and in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereinafter referred to as "R.M. of White Valley"

the party of the fourth part

- and -

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF GRASSY CREEK NO. 78, a municipal corporation of and in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereinafter referred to as "R.M. of Grassy Creek"

the party of the fifth part

- and -

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ARLINGTON NO. 79, a municipal corporation of and in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereinafter referred to as "R.M. of Arlington"

the party of the sixth part

- and -

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BONE CREEK NO. 108, a municipal corporation of and in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereinafter referred to as "R.M. of Bone Creek"

the party of the seventh part

WITNESSES the parties desire to associate with each other for the purpose of establishing and operating a regional park pursuant to the provisions of The Regional Parks Act, hereinafter called the "Act" upon the areas commonly referred to as "Five Creeks", "Five Creeks, Shaunavon Division" and "Five Creeks, Eastend Division".

NOW THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH that in consideration of the presents and covenants, promises and agreements hereinafter contained, the parties hereto jointly and severally agree as follows:

1. The parties agree to associate and work together to elect a Regional Park Authority and to create a regional park in accordance with the provisions of the Regional Parks Act and Regulations.

2. To maintain and operate as a regional park until a Regional Park Authority is appointed by the parties and constituted under the Act, all those parcels of land commonly referred to as "Pine Cree", "Pine Cree, Shaunavon Division" and "Pine Cree, Eastend Division" and more particularly described as follows:
SEE LAND SCHEDULE ATTACHED - SCHEDULE A

3. Each party agrees to make annual grants under Section 14 of the Act in order to share all costs to be borne by the parties and capital costs of proposed development up to a maximum of Six Thousand, Four hundred dollars (\$6,400) in any one year over a period of five years from the date hereof of the regional park created upon the said lands in the following proportions:

4. Each party agrees to designate one or more representatives to act with the other representatives named by the parties in order to conduct preliminary negotiations and the preparation of plans for the regional park and to prepare a submission for assistance under Section 6 of the Act.
5. The parties agree to perform and do all acts necessary in order to ratify and confirm this agreement and in particular the parties agree to pass a complementary bylaw authorizing the execution and performance of this agreement.
6. The parties agree that there shall be no liability arising from this agreement for the cost of operating or maintaining the regional park after five (5) years from April 1, 1974.
7. This agreement shall be renewable at the end of five years should the municipalities participating under this agreement so desire.
